Outline of the offered course

The child’s writing development: developmental stages, Literacy theories –Critical investigation of theoretical approaches, Emergent Writing: The specific way of structuring and operating writing and the procedures of emergent literacy. The “Emergent Literacy” concept: children’s initial ideas for writing and its functions, Factors effecting Emergent Literacy, Emergent Literacy and the Primary School. The use of children’s initial ideas in first writing. Psycho-kinesthetic and cognitive functions and skills and the teaching of writing (symbolic function, visual perception and visual memory, visual-kinesthetic coordination, fine motor skills, perception of space, time and rhythm, consolidating laterality , speaking), Handwriting movement, Writing as cognitive meaning-making process. The text as a social activity –Functional text approach, The relationship between speaking - writing and its impact on the acquisition of literacy, The reading - writing relationship, Teaching approaches for first writing: Presentation and critical investigation, Types and means of assessing the development of first writing, Individual differences in writing development, Problems-difficulties in writing development: causes, workarounds, Cross Thematic Curriculum Frameworks for Compulsory Education and the teaching of first writing (contents, activities, didactic examples).

- “School Practice B”

At "Level B" of the School of Practice, 7th semester students work on alternative forms of teaching and learning and teach for one week at rural schools in Rethimnon Pref.

The first general meeting includes all supervisors, assistants and all the students that have successfully completed the “School Practice A- Level 1”. Students are divided into groups of 30-33, based on the groups that were formed in "School Practice Level 1" and they are allocated to the designated practice schools of Rethimnon. If a student wishes to change groups, this can only be done at the first organizational meeting and only by mutual transfer. The supervisor designated for each group is based on the alphabetical classification of the supervisors’ names. In the first organizational meeting between the supervisor, his/her assistant and their subgroup, students are divided into pairs. In case there is an inadequate number of assistants, one assistant works with two teaching supervisors and guides the students from two groups instead of one. Next, the students are informed on the alternative forms of teaching and learning by participating in three workshops, which take place at the University of Crete during the first three weeks of the semester. One of the alternative forms of teaching workshops focuses on the interdisciplinary approach to teaching and the “project” method. The teaching supervisor / or his/her assistant, may seek to co-organize the workshops with colleagues from other disciplines. From the 4th until the 12th week of the semester, four student-groups teach at the practice schools every Tuesday and the other three groups teach every Thursday. In collaboration with the regular teacher and guided by the assistant, the student prepares all school subjects and teachers the first four hours. The second student from the same group, monitors the first student, records his/her observations and provides help wherever is needed. The teaching supervisor and his / her assistant are at the school and monitor the students teaching. During the 5th and 6th hour, the teaching supervisor, the students and the assistants gather together and present their observations on the teachings, reflect on them, express their opinions, exercise well-intentioned criticism, discuss alternative ways of organizing teaching and propose measures to address any problems. Colleagues from other subjects, the regular class teachers or the school’s principle can also participate. The following week, the students switch roles. During "Level B", students apply alternative forms of teaching and learning such as the interdisciplinary approach to teaching, the project method, team teaching, individualized teaching, collaborative learning, discovery learning, dramatization, role-play, the use of ICT in teaching, etc. The Level coordinator in collaboration with the teaching assistants ensures that there is proper planning so that all students teach one week during the 5th -12th week in rural schools of Rethimno, giving priority to the team teaching classes. During the last week (the 13th week), the sub-groups have debriefing discussions and then there is a general debriefing discussion that includes all groups and entails reflection in order to reorganize and improve Level B School Practice.

Student obligations

At the end of "Level B", each student hands to his/her supervisor a "Personal portfolio" which includes: a) the "Bulletin of School Practice", supplemented by the workshops he/she participated and the teachings he/she carried out, b) the organizing plans from the three different alternative teachings he/she carried out during "Level B", including the material he/she used for them (one of them must include the interdisciplinary approach), c) a report on his/her experience at the school he/she taught for a week d) a self-assessment report e) his/her suggestions on reorganizing and improving Level B and f) any extra material the students deems as necessary in order to better evaluate him/her.

Student evaluation

Student evaluation criteria include a) his/her teaching ability and awareness of alternative forms of teaching and learning, b) his/her active participation in workshops and discussions, c) the "Personal Portfolio" content handed after the completion of Level B and d) continuous student monitoring during the “Level B” of the School Practice.

Short description:
The aim of the "Language Development" module is to explore current research and scientific reflections on the development of speaking and writing, with special emphasis on cultural and social aspects associated with the learning process. The module provides a perspective on educational issues in conjunction with modern linguistic considerations. Specifically, it posits the study of language within social contexts and distances itself from the study of language as an autonomous system that characterizes traditional grammar and the genetic Chomskian perception. The relationship between language and society is studied under the classic sociolinguistic model, but also within the framework of "critical discourse analysis." The role of speaking in learning and the significance of literacy policies in modern societies are also emphasized.
